

WLD Ranch Retreat Rates 2025

WLD Ranch can accommodate groups from 10 to 160 people. There are three lodging facilities (bunkbeds - bring your own bedding) with meeting spaces available for each. All lodging and meeting facilities are heated and have indoor bathrooms. **WLD Ranch provides all meals for groups using the facilities, serving in the Longhorn Lodge dining room.**

Retreat Packages

Retreats typically begin Friday evening and end Saturday or Sunday. Packages include meals for Saturday and Sunday. Other options may be available upon request. (Prices are per person.)

Option A – Two overnights, five meals - \$105.00	Option B - Two overnights, four meals - \$92.00
Option C – One overnight, three meals - \$64.00	Option D - One overnight, two meals - \$51.00

The WLD Ranch can provide a pizza snack (with chips and water/koolaid) for an additional **\$5.00/person** (Friday night).

Activities Rates

Hayride	Tractor-drawn wagon (up to 25 people; approx. 30 min.)	\$40.00 fee (additional wagon is \$25)
Horse-drawn Wagon Ride	(up to 15 people per wagon; approx. 20 min.)	\$30.00 fee (\$2.00 per additional passenger)
Horse rides	Approx. 25 minute ride at a walk - 8-10 people per ride	\$5.00/ rider
<i>Hayrides and horse rides are dependent on weather and trail conditions. Horse rides will be trail rides (for 5th grade and older) but we can give rides in the indoor arena if weather prevents use of the trails. Please respect the functional requirements for horse riding: riders must weigh less than 250 lbs. and must be capable of mounting the horse with minimal assistance.</i>		
Challenge Course	Groups of 60 or more - \$1 per person per hour	
	Groups of less than 60 people – up to 2 hrs. (4-6 initiatives) - no cost	
	(\$2 per person for each additional hour on the course)	
Riflery	\$0.10 per shot (or a \$25.00 use fee for groups that bring their own .22 ammunition)	

Additional activities listed on the contract are available for no additional cost within a limited timeframe for freetime activities.

Facility Descriptions

The Longhorn Lodge is centrally located on our property. Within the Longhorn Lodge you will find the Dining Room, Chapel, Double R Game Room, and Staff Offices. Our Dining Room feeds up to 180 people from a commercial kitchen. Near the Dining Room, there are two full bathrooms and our Nurse’s Office. The Chapel holds up to 180 people (multimedia supplies are available). The Game Room provides a variety of games such as carpetball and ping pong.

The Buckskin Bunkhouse is divided into four sleeping areas, each sleeping 20 people (total capacity 80). Each sleeping area has its own bathroom, allowing the bunkhouse to be divided for men and women. **The Latigo**, a meeting room or gathering space, is conveniently adjacent to the sleeping areas of the Buckskin Bunkhouse (limited multimedia supplies are available). Paired with the Longhorn Lodge, this facility is ideal for groups of 30 to 80 people.

The Silver Star Station is divided into four sleeping areas, each sleeping 18 people (total capacity 72). The Silver Star has two large bathrooms that divide the bunkhouse in half for men and women. **The Spur**, a meeting room or gathering space for up to 50 people, is conveniently adjacent to the sleeping areas of the Silver Star Station (limited multimedia supplies are available). The Silver Star and Spur are ideal for groups of 20 to 50 people.

The Wrangler's Roost is a small sleeping facility for up to 20 people with two bathrooms (one on each floor). There are convenient entrances for both the upstairs and downstairs from the outside (to separate for men and women). *This sleeping facility may be paired with a meeting location in the Longhorn Lodge, depending on availability.*

Typical Facility Arrangements

Typical combinations of sleeping facility and meeting room are listed below, but we will work with your group to arrange the appropriate lodging and meeting space depending on availability and number of participants.

Buckskin Bunkhouse (lodging) and Longhorn Lodge (meals and meetings) (BB/LL)

For groups of 30 to 80 people (typically a minimum charge for 30)

Silver Star Station (lodging and meetings) and Longhorn Lodge (meals) (SS)

For groups of 20 to 50 people (typically a minimum charge for 20)

Wrangler’s Roost (lodging) and Longhorn Lodge (meals and meetings) (WR)

For groups of 10 to 20 people (by special arrangement only)

Silver Star Station and Buckskin Bunkhouse (lodging) with Longhorn Lodge (meals and meetings)

For groups of 80 to 150 people (typically a minimum charge for 80) (SS/BB/LL)
