RANCH HAND

A Ranch Hand at WLD Ranch is responsible for washing dishes after every meal, emptying trash around the property daily, and completing various maintenance tasks (cutting grass, bringing in hay, stacking firewood, pool maintenance, etc.) as needed.

QUALIFICATIONS:

A Ranch Hand...

- 1. Is willing to abide by WLD Ranch Staff Policies.
- 2. Is willing to serve in a Christian camp setting.
- 3. Is willing to accept responsibility.
- 4. Is between ages 14 and 17.
- 5. Is in good health and is physically able to navigate outdoor terrain including steep hills and uneven surfaces without assistance
- 6. Must be male.

EXPECTATIONS:

A Ranch Hand will . . .

- 1. Attend all required **Staff Training** sessions.
- 2. Abide by WLD Ranch **Staff Policies**.
- 3. Carry out assigned daily and weekly duties.
- 4. Attend all meetings and participate in the camp program as schedule permits.
- 5. Complete tasks with a good attitude.
- 6. Strive to maintain unity within the Kitchen Department and within the WLD Ranch staff as a whole, working in peace with others.
- 7. Conduct himself in a way that contributes to the mental, social, and emotional well-being of everyone at WLD Ranch.
- 8. Conduct himself in a way that contributes to the safety of every person at WLD Ranch.
- 9. Contribute to a positive environment within the staff bunkhouse.
- 10. Practice personal cleanliness/hygiene.
- 11. Follow Food Safe practices in the dishroom as mandated by the Erie County Department of Health.
- 12. Be responsible to the Foreman and Assistant Foreman and his supervisors according to the Chain of Command.

TYPCIAL DUTIES:

A Ranch Hand will . . .

- 1. Wash all dishes, pots, and pans after each meal.
- 2. Complete daily and weekly chores with the Foreman and Assistant Foreman (emptying trash, pool maintenance, cutting grass, etc.).
- 3. Complete various maintenance tasks around the property as assigned by Maintenance leadership.
