Not every day at camp do we see this much fruitfulness, yet each day is another day for allowing Jesus to work through our words and our lives to transform lives for His glory.

Camp is powerful. It transforms the lives of campers and guests, and it transforms the lives of the staff and volunteers who serve. We are so grateful to the Lord that we get to be a part of this incredible ministry and we look forward to seeing what God will accomplish in the years ahead.

As we look toward the new year, we desire to see the impact of camp continue and thrive. For the ministry to thrive, we rely on God's provision through donors like you. Finally, we focus on *people*, seeking to make a difference for Jesus in every life touched by this ministry, whether summer campers, retreat guests, horse lesson students, families attending community events, school students learning to work as a team, or the staff and volunteers that make this ministry possible.
